- A. Following categories of persons shall be automatically included in the list of Eligible households:-
- All families indentified as AAY beneficiaries in the State as per the updated lists approved during the Gram Sabha meetings.
- All families, identified as Below Poverty Line households (BPL) and Additional households for subsidized rations at BPL rates and are not already covered under AAY scheme as per the updated lists approved by the respective Gram Panchayats during the Gram Sabha meetings.
- Households with any member receiving pensions from Department of Social Justice and Empowerment like old age pension, widow pension, disabled pension, lepers pension.
- 4. Households with a beneficiary under Annapurna Anna Yojana scheme.
- 5. All Tibetans or refugee who are verified by Tibetan Settlement Officer.

In case of a situation, where a households name figures in more than one category, the name of the household shall be considered once.

- B. Inclusion/Exclusion criteria for left out households:
- 1. Inclusion criteria:

The households in a Local Body shall be included in the list in the following order of

- i) Aikal Naris.
- ii) Orphans, abandoned children and those residing in Ahrams.

The condition of barring BPL Household of having Pucca Urban Type Big House shall not be applicable for selection of household under NFSA for this additional upto 10% population...

Remaining conditions contained in the Notification dated 01-08-2013 would remain the same including the process of Selection of Household which may be undertaken again now in order to include the above categories for which Rurai Development Department and Urban Development Department may take necessary action.

- iv) Any household whose any member is drawing pension from any State or . Central Government, Boards, Corporations, Autonomous Bodies, Banks, Govt. Sector, undertakings and Local bodies.

In case, household falls in both inclusion criteria and exclusion criteria, the exclusion criteria shall prevail and such household shall not be considered for inclusion in the list of Eligible household.

Remaining conditions contained in the Notification dates August, 2013 and dated 24th November, 2016 would remain me including the process of Selection of Households which have be undertaken again now in order to include the above categolies for which Rural Development Department and Urban Development Department may take necessary action.
